General Information and Rules

General Information

Pages are leased on an annual basis, June 1 to June 1. On payment of the appropriate lease and new page fees, the artist's page will be assigned a listing number and the artist given a personal password for access to their page to write and/or modify text and upload photos. When a visitor to the site selects pages by subject/medium, pages meeting the selection will queue in order of their listing number. There is no limit to the number of pages a member may lease. Consider a second page if you work in more than one medium. No discounts for multiple page leasing.

Rules

1. Gallery pages may not be transferred.
2. Nude art or art which may be considered offensive should not be displayed on the Artist Gallery.
3. The Club reserves the right to require removal of any art it considers offensive.
4. Gallery pages are leased to members in good standing. Failing this or failing to remove a photo from the gallery when asked, a page may be removed by 2/3rds vote of the Board of Directors.
5. The Club may immediately remove a member page from the Gallery for failure to pay the annual , lease renewal on time. On time means, on or before June 1 of each year.
6. The club reserves the right to remove a member page for failure to pay the Club's annual dues within thirty days of the member's due date.

How to Lease a Gallery Page

Fill out the application form online, print out a copy and mail it or deliver it with your check for the appropriate fees payable to Vero Beach Art Club, Inc. to Artist Gallery, Vero Beach Art Club, 3001 Riverside Drive, Vero Beach, FL 32963 On receipt you'll be given your listing number and password.

Annual Lease Fee

The fee is \$ per year, June 1 to June 1. With a link to your personal website the fee is \$. No partial year leases are permitted. Leasing a page prior to June 1 of any year requires the \$25 annual fee plus \$ or (\$ plus link) for each month remaining in the current year. Failure to renew your lease on time will result in removal of your gallery page. To restore your page you must pay the current one time "new page" fee plus the appropriate annual lease renewal fee.

New Page (One Time) Fee

A one time fee of \$ is required per page. \$ for a page with a link to your personal website. The fee must be repaid if the page is not renewed on time. See rules.

Setting Up Your Gallery Page

To set up your page, write a biography, select and crop photos of your art, title them, size them and note any other facts to put on the pop-up enlarged photo page. Example: Picture created from a photo taken in my garden. Or Photo taken by the artist of _____ in Paris, May 2002. Are reprints available? When you have gathered your information and photo's go online. To access your gallery page, enter your password in the place indicated on the Artist Gallery home page and follow the instructions.

1 Loading Text, Photos and Photo Text

To upload text and photo's, just follow the instructions on the application page and photo text page. Text fields are limited. Abbreviate, use a lower case etc. if needed.

2. Changing Text, Photos, and Photo Text

Changes may be made any time. Access your page via your password and follow the instructions. If you prefer to have photos uploaded for you, enter text for each photo on the photo page, submit the photos with a check for the appropriate fee (see photo page) to the host company.

3. Links to Personal Web Sites.

If ordered, the link to your website will appear at the bottom of photo pop-up enlargement pages.
