- 3. ART BY THE SEA and UNDER THE OAKS shows both require many volunteers.
- 4. Volunteer to help at Art by the Sea, Under the Oaks, Art Trail etc.
- 5. Set-up and take down artwork at non-juried shows. Volunteer hours equal time spent.
- 6. Video editing, photography of events, art demonstrations, etc.

#### FURTHER IMPORTANT DETAILS

- If you do not have the required meeting or credit hours, you can still enter "UNDER THE OAKS" as a non-member; however, you will not be included in the reserved spaces for Members Only and your entry will be juried with the hundreds of International applicants we receive each year. Since this is a juried show, your chances of acceptance are greatly reduced by entering with the general public.
- Each of the shows (UNDER THE OAKS and ART IN THE PARK) require their own separate hours. You must have a total of (25 hours UTO and 15 hours AITP) credit hours to enter both shows. Since these are juried shows, having the number of hours required does not guarantee acceptance into the shows; It only qualifies you to enter as an art club member.
- Attendance and Volunteer Hours do not carry over to the next year.
- Qualifying hours for both "UNDER THE OAKS" and "ART IN THE PARK" begin accruing as soon as the entry deadline for that event has passed. Hours may not be combined and used for both events. You will need a total of 40 hours to do both events. You will also need to attend 3 general meetings to participate in either one of these events (total of 3 to participate in both events).
- All shows can be entered on-line with paid membership dues, qualifying volunteer hours and meeting attendance.
